WSDA Pesticide License Types

All licenses expire annually on December 31, with the exception of Limited & Rancher Private Applicator licenses, which are 5-year licenses expiring on December 31 of the fifth year.

License Type	Definitions
Commercial Operator	Employed by a commercial applicator company to use pesticides on the land or property of another. This land or property can be publicly or privately owned. This license is not valid unless working for a licensed Commercial Applicator.
Commercial Applicator	Engaged in the business of using pesticides on land or property of another. This land or property can be publicly or privately owned. Other requirements apply; visit agr.wa.gov .
Structural Pest Inspector *	Inspects a structure for wood-destroying organisms (WDOs) or conditions conducive to their development. WDOs include carpenter and moisture ants, termites, wood-infesting beetles, and wood rot (fungus). Other requirements apply; visit agr.wa.gov .
Private-Commercial Applicator	Uses or supervises the use of a restricted use pesticide on land owned or rented by them or their employer for purposes other than the production of an agricultural commodity.
Dealer Manager	Supervises the distribution of non-home and garden pesticides from a licensed pesticide dealer outlet. This license is not valid unless working for a licensed Pesticide Dealer.
Public Operator **	While acting as a government employee, uses restricted use pesticides by any means or general use pesticides by power equipment on public or private property. This license is not valid unless working for a public agency.
Public Pest Control Consultant **	While acting as a government employee, offers or supplies technical advice, supervision, aid, or makes recommendations to any user of non-home and garden pesticides. This license is not valid unless working for a public agency.
Commercial Pest Control Consultant	Sells or offers pesticides for sale at locations other than the licensed pesticide dealer where they are employed. In addition, consultants may offer or supply technical advice, aid, or make recommendations to the users of non-home and garden pesticides. Licensed and employed Commercial Applicators and Operators may act as commercial consultants without acquiring the license.
Demonstration & Research	Uses or supervises the use of any experimental or restricted use pesticide at no charge on small experimental plots for research purposes.
Private Applicator *	Uses or supervises the use of any pesticide through chemigation equipment or any restricted use pesticide on land or property owned or rented by them or their employer for the purpose of producing an agricultural commodity.
Limited Private Applicator * Rancher Private Applicator *	<p>Both allow use or supervision of use of restricted use herbicides on non-production agricultural land and in mixed rangeland-timber areas to control weeds designated for mandatory control.</p> <p>Rancher Private Applicators may also use restricted use herbicides and rodenticides to limited production agricultural land where hay and grain are grown for on-farm use.</p> <p>Neither license allows use of restricted use insecticides, fungicides, or aquatic herbicides. Both are valid in Eastern Washington only.</p>

**Fee is not required if applicant already has a valid Commercial Applicator, Commercial Operator, Private Commercial Applicator, Commercial Consultant, Demonstration and Research, Public Operator, or Public Consultant license.*

***Public agency purchase orders are not accepted. State agencies may pay with journal voucher (JV), crediting agency 495, fund 126.*
